PRE-REGISTRATION

- Online registration is available at www.asev.org. Please follow the online instructions.
- If you choose to register by fax or mail, please complete the attendee registration form and return it with your full payment to the address listed at the bottom of the form no later than June 3, 2008.
- You must register by June 3 to receive pre-registration rates. If you choose to register by mail, the envelope must be postmarked by this date.
- Registration forms received or postmarked after June 3 will be considered on-site and the applicable late fees will apply.
- **After June 3, you must register on-site and rates will be \$200 higher, except Supplier Showcase Only registration.**

Confirmations

Badges

Payment

- Registration fees must be paid in advance.
- ASEV accepts MasterCard, VISA, Discover, Diner's Club and American Express. We will only accept faxed registration forms if payment is made by credit card.
- Only submit your registration form once. If you are faxing your registration form with credit card payment, do not also mail it.
- Make checks payable to Conference Registration. Please mail registration form with a check. If paying by check, do not fax registration form.

Cancellation Policy

- Refund requests must be submitted in writing to Conference Registration.
- Your request must be received or postmarked by June 3, 2008. No refunds will be given after this date.
- A \$50 service charge will apply to each event. This includes the symposia.
- There will be no refunds for student, Supplier Showcase only or winery tour registration fees.
